LYNDEBOROUGH TOWN MEETING

The Town Meeting will take place at the **Citizens' Hall** on **Saturday, March 17th at 10 AM**. The Town will vote on a number of distinct measures, which are called "Warrant Articles". This voter guide has been prepared by the *Wilton-Lyndeborough Taxpayers*, which is a group of residents of both towns whose goal is to ensure fiscally-responsible government and to help keep taxes low.

Warrant Article #	Recommendation	
1-3	SEE NOTE	Articles 1 through 3 are not voted on at the Town Meeting. Instead, they are voted on at the Town Election, which takes place this year on Tuesday, March 13 th . Vote at Town Hall. Polls open at 8 AM and close no earlier than 7 PM. There is a separate VOTER GUIDE FOR LYNDEBOROUGH TOWN ELECTIONS. Please download it from www.wltaxpayers.org.
4	YES	Lyndeborough Town Budget: This article would pass the proposed budget, which amounts to \$2,042,032. This is an increase of approximately \$56,000, which is about 2.9%.
5	YES	\$56,000 for the Fire Dept. Pumper Capital Reserve Fund.
6	YES	\$40,000 for the Fire Dept. Tanker Capital Reserve Fund.
7	YES	Police vehicle purchase for \$41,000: \$20k in non-lapsing Warrant Article and \$21k raised through taxation.
8	YES	Dump Truck purchase for \$220,000: This purchase will draw \$171k from the reserve fund, with another \$49k to be raised through taxation.
9	YES	Capital Reserve Fund Change of Purpose: This item has no immediate tax impact.
10	YES	\$14,000 for the Ambulance & Medical Equipment Capital Reserve Fund.
11	NEUTRAL	Paving of Citizens Hall Parking Lot for \$22,000.
12	NEUTRAL	Paving of Library Parking Lot for \$8,000.
13	NEUTRAL	Street Light Study Committee. This item has no immediate tax impact.
14	TBD	To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.
